ENTRY REQUIREMENT

- (i) Pass in STPM with a minimum Grade C (GP2.0) in any 2 subjects, and a pass in Mathematics and English at SPM level, or any equivalent qualification;
- (ii) Pass in STAM with a minimum grade of Jayyid, and a pass in Mathematics and English at SPM level;
- (iii) Any qualifications equivalent to Diploma or Advanced Diploma (Level 4 or 5, MQF);
 OR
- (iv) Matriculation/Foundation qualification with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 out of 4.00, or any equivalent qualification.
- Note: The requirement to pass Mathematics and English subjects at SPM level for candidate in category (i) and (ii) can be waived should the qualifications contain Mathematics and English subjects with equivalent/higher achievement than SPM.
- International students are required to achieve a minimum score of 5.5 for IELTS OR its
 equivalent
- Pass A-level with minimum Grade D in any 2 subjects, and a pass in Mathematics and English at O level, or any equivalent qualification;
- Pass Higher National Diploma (HND) UK (MQF Level 4) in related area and recognized government of Malaysia and according to approval by UniKL Senate.
- Pass Diploma Kemahiran Malaysia (DKM)/Diploma Lanjutan Kemahiran Malaysia (DLKM)/Diploma Vokasional Malaysia (DVM) with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 subject to the approval of the Senate/Academic Board of the relevant institution;
- Pass the DKM/DLKM/DVM with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 AND have at least two (2) years of work experience in the related field.
