APEL is a systematic process that involves the identification, documentation and assessment of prior experiential learning, i.e. knowledge, skills and attitudes, to determine the extent to which an individual has achieved the desired learning outcomes, for access to a programme of study and/or award of credits.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT

- A Bachelor's degree with minimum CGPA of 2.5 out of 4.00, OR its equivalent qualifications as accepted by the Higher Education Provider (HEP) Senate; OR
- A Bachelor's degree with CGPA below 2.50 out of 4.00, OR its equivalent qualifications can be accepted, subject to a minimum of 5 years working experience in relevant field.
- International Students are required to achieve a minimum score of 6.0 for IELTS or its equivalent.
